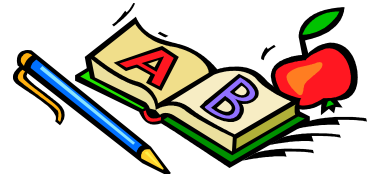

Phrases with WANT

I want that.
I want it.
I want to play.
He wants it.
I want more.
Do you want it?
Not want it.
Want to go.
What you want.

We continue to model these phrases using core vocabulary word, sign language, and saying the words.

Ask your child to show you the sign for WANT and find WANT on core vocabulary board.



Activities with word WANT:
Emphasize the words WANT when you ask your child, "What do you WANT?" When having child pick food, song, tv show, and toys have child say, sign, or point to WANT when making choice. Talk about what child WANTS for Christmas. Show sign WANT, point to word WANT, or say WANT many times.
