

Speech and Language Services

Speech and Language services are available to any student who is determined eligible through the evaluation process. These services may be provided within the classroom setting by the Speech-Language Pathologist or by taking the child out of the classroom and working with the child in a small group or individually. The IEP team determines the number of therapy minutes received by each child.

The Speech-Language Pathologist collaborates with the classroom teacher in the MSI, Autism, and ECE classrooms to provide language development activities for the entire class. Additional activities are sent home with the students as needed to further develop speech and language skills.

Speech and Language Pathologists work closely with classroom staff as well as other related service providers. Speech and Language Pathologists will complete and send home Quarterly Progress Reports for each quarter. An annual review meeting will be conducted to review your child's progress on individual goals and objectives then to determine goals and objectives for the next year.
