Governing and Executive Board(s)-Director Relationship

The Board employs and evaluates the Director and holds him or her responsible for the operation of the District in accordance with Board policies and State and federal law.

The Board-Director relationship is based on mutual respect for their complementary roles. The relationship requires clear communication of expectations regarding the duties and responsibilities of both the Board and Director.

The Governing Board employs the Director as the District chief executive officer and seeks his/her recommendations. The Board adopts policies necessary to provide general direction for the District and to encourage achievement of District goals. The Director develops plans, programs, and procedures needed to implement the policies and directs the District's day-to-day operations.
