### MOBILITY

- Lifts head
- Rolls over
- Sits with support

- Understand directions with a specific order

- Understand directions containing propositions, e.g.; "on", "in", etc.

### SOCIALIZATION

- Recognizes family members
- Recognizes other non-family members
- Knows information about others, e.g., job, address, relation to self
- Shows affection to others
- Is careful not to hurt self
- Is careful not to hurt others
- Is careful not to disturb others' belongings or damage property
- Has preference for some persons over others
- Does not respond to others in a socially acceptable manner
- Does not respond to others in a socially acceptable manner
- Has little interaction with others
- Participates in group activities if encouraged
- Participates in groups spontaneously
- Cooperates and shares with others
- Willingly obeys simple commands
- Will not engage in assigned activities
- Initiates most of own activities
- Maintains self control when angry
- Seeks attention in appropriate ways

## MONEY HANDLING

- Does not use money
- Uses money, but does not make correct change
- Adds different coins up to one dollar
- Makes change correctly with coins and dollars
- Uses bank facilities independently

## PURCHASING

- Does no shopping
- Does shopping with close supervision
- Does shopping with slight supervision
- Makes minor purchases independently
- Buys own clothing accessories
- Buys all of own clothing

## VOCATIONAL

- Able to navigate living area alone
- Able to navigate a few blocks from home independently
- Able to navigate several blocks from familiar area independently
- Write and prints own name
- Writes and prints ten words
- Writes and prints forty words
- Writes and prints short notes or memos
- Recognizes fewer than 10 words
- Recognizes ten or more words by sight
- Reads various signs "Women", "Men", etc.
- Reads simple stories or comics
- Discriminates between one, many and a lot
- Counts two objects
- Mechanically counts to ten
- Counts ten or more objects
- Able to do simple addition and subtraction
- Understand concept of time, but not able to tell time independently
- Is able to follow a picture schedule to determine when events occur
- Associates time with various actions or events
- Tells time correctly to the hour
- Tells time correctly hourly intervals
- Performs simple tasks with assistance
- Performs simple work independently, e.g. mopping, wiping tables, assembly work
- Performs a job requiring use of tools or machinery, e.g. shop work, yard work
- Able to pay attention for intervals of five minutes
- Able to pay attention for intervals of fifteen minutes
- Able to pay attention for intervals of more than fifteen minutes
