IDEAS FOR USING HE AND SHE

- 1. Create opportunities to model "more" by only giving a small amount of an item or an action to a student, then waiting to see if they want more. Some simple ideas include:
 - Block building: Give one block at a time
 - Playdoh: Give one small blob of playdoh
 - Bubbles: Blow once
 - Drawing: Give one pen
 - Balloons: Blow up a little bit
 - Swing: One push of the swing
 - Tickles: One tickle at a time
 - Music: Play and pause the music
 - Instruments and singing: Play instruments and sing, and pause.
