TENTATIVE MINUTES

The March meeting of the South Eastern Special Education Executive Board was held Wednesday, March 17, 2021 at 9:30 a.m., at the SESE Central Office in Ste. Marie, IL. Jeff Patchett, Acting Chairperson for the SESE Executive Board, called the meeting to order at 9:35 a.m.

The agenda was presented for review. Quick moved, seconded by Hackney to approve the agenda. Roll call vote was taken with all present voting yea. Motion carried.

The consent agenda was presented for review. Simpson moved, seconded by Johnson to approve the consent agenda. Roll call vote was taken with all present voting yea. Motion carried.

There was a brief discussion regarding the Building Committee's recommendations.

The Executive Board did not go into closed session.

Hackney moved, seconded by Wyatt to approve the Leave Request for Taylor Stanley, Speech Language Pathologist, to return retroactive March 2, 2021 instead of March 29, 2021. Roll call vote was taken with Johnson, Simpson, Kraemer, Quick, Patchett, Wyatt and Hackney voting yea. Motion carried.

There was a brief discussion regarding the Districts' completion of the Consolidated District Plan in regards to IDEA Part B Flow-Through and Pre-School Grants.


The Districts' Special Education Data Profiles were discussed and shared.
