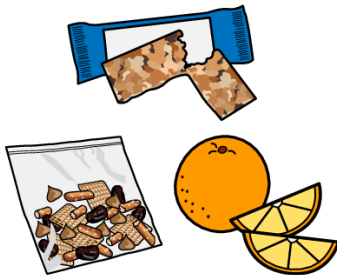

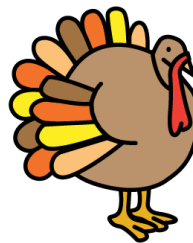
In the Kitchen Healthy Snacks

Fall Science Experiments & Activities

There's a LOT of science that happens outside during the Fall season:

- leaves change colors
- animals start hibernation, migration or adaptation behaviors
- the night sky begins to shift - kids probably notice you can see the moon both at night & in the morning
- the days become shorter and cooler
- and trees begin to shed both their leaves and seeds)

In addition to talking with kids about the seasonal changes they see around them, try a few of these hands-on activities and experiments that introduce your kids to different science concepts.
